The Director of Wastewater Operations reports to the Chief Engineer and Director and is responsible for incorporating best-in class maintenance management practices for a system which includes 96 miles of interceptors, 18 pumping stations, and a 50 MGD capacity wastewater treatment plant. The Director manages an annual budget of \$10.4 million and 49 employees.

Position requires a Bachelor's degree, Master's degree preferred, in public works; environmental studies; sustainability; civil, chemical, mechanical or environmental engineering or a related field, and ten years of progressively responsible public or private sector wastewater treatment administration, including at least five years of supervisory experience. Possession of a Professional Engineer's license is preferred. Qualified candidates must demonstrate a deep understanding of wastewater processes and infrastructure management and have, or obtain within one year of hire, an ENV SP credential from the Institute for Sustainable Infrastructure.
