FUNCTION:

The City of Ankeny is seeking applicants for the fulltime position of Civil Engineer II, which will report to the Public Works Engineering Manager within the Public Works Department.

The full salary range is **\$81,981 – \$110,018** with a starting range of **\$81,981 - \$94,903**, depending on experience, plus excellent benefits. Pre-employment drug screen and background check required.

Deadline to apply is May 23, 2021 at 11:59 PM. Interested applicants should apply online and provide a cover letter, resume, and a copy of their Professional Engineer certificate.

PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepares, reviews, and approves designs, plans, specifications, and cost estimates for public infrastructure projects including street and utility improvements.
- Reviews street pavement, water main, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, and sidewalk/trail design and construction for compliance with Statewide Urban Design and Specifications (SUDAS) and City of Ankeny standards.
- Assists with the preparation of the City's annual Capital Improvement Program (CIP), including developing public improvement concepts and generating conceptual cost estimates.
- Manages consultant-designed capital improvement projects and acts as the City's point of contact during the design and construction phases. Coordinates decisions with the consultant and applicable City staff across departments. Attends weekly construction meetings on the City's behalf.
- Assists with the management of the in-house engineering design and preparation of construction documents for capital improvement projects including plans, specifications, cost estimates, and bidding documents, and conducting project information meetings.
- Performs construction administration on in-house designed public improvement projects including leading preconstruction meetings, preparing payment applications, reviewing change orders, and overseeing project closeouts.
- Supervises the Civil Engineering Technicians when they complete construction observation and testing of construction materials for in-house inspected public improvement projects.

- Maintains files, folders, and record drawings for consultant designed public improvement projects in paper copy and digital format. Assists with the work activities for the City's GIS database management.
- Responds to inquiries and concerns from residents, businesses, contractors, and consultants regarding public infrastructure improvements, completes on-site investigations, and acts as the City's representative.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND SKILLS:

Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, or closely related field; and a minimum of four (4) years of progressively responsible work experience in civil engineering; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Knowledge of modern principles and practices of public works and civil engineering; knowledge of AutoCAD Civil 3D software (or equivalent) and ArcReader GIS software (or equivalent); ability to coordinate and supervise the activities of engineering division personnel; ability to manage multiple tasks simultaneously; ability to communicate and cooperate with officials, co-workers, consulting engineers, contractors, and the general public.

REQUIRED SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be in possession of a license to practice as a professional civil engineer issued by the State of Iowa or licensed in another state with the ability to obtain an Iowa license within six (6) months of date of hire.

Shall possess and maintain a valid motor vehicle operator's license issued by the State of Iowa.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Works in office environment.
- Occasional work in the field or at off-site locales.
- May be required to participate in meetings after normal working hours.
- Must keep regular and reliable attendance at work.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Work requires occasional exertion of up to 25 pounds of force.
- Must be insurable.
- Must be sighted.
- Must be able to hear a normal conversation.
- Must be able to speak clearly at normal rate of conversation.
- Must be able to kneel, squat, and walk.
